



# **ODH Program**


- PrEP assistance program
- Began in 2019
- Developed by ODH and regional PrEP workgroups
- For Ohio residents
- To qualify:
  - Live in Ohio
  - Be HIV negative
  - Income: </= \$72,900 (500% of the Federal Poverty Guideline)
- Pays PAPI Providers directly
- Med office visits and labs
- Does not pay for drug







# Policy - H.R. 4392; S. 2188 and Braidwood Management v. Becerra




- H.R. 4392; S. 2188; PrEP Access and Coverage Act
  - Introduced by democrats Sen. Tina Smith and Rep. Adam Schiff in June 2023
  - Would require priv/pub insurance with no cost-sharing to patients
  - Grant programs for states/territories for uninsured patients
- Referred to Subcommittee on Health Affairs in August 2023
- Braidwood v. Becerra
  - Conservative Texas court
  - Judged in favor of plaintiff... with restrictions
  - "Error" for Judge O'Connor to block all USPSTF requirements nationwide
  - Preventive care in jeopardy
